Status on the implementation of Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/732 and Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/858

In reply to the inquiry from Mr Herald Ruijters on behalf of DG Move, Denmark is hereby sending a short update on the implementation of article 7.3 in Directive 2014/94/EU on the deployment of alternative fuels infrastructure (AFID) and the Implementing regulation (EU) 2018/732 on a common methodology for alternative fuels unit price comparison in accordance with Directive 2014/94 / EU of the European Parliament and of the Council and Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/858 amending Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/732.

Denmark has implemented Article 7.3 in AFID and accompanying implementing regulations. The Danish Road Traffic Authority has issued the executive order no. 1037 of 28th of May 2021 on requirements for publicly accessible infrastructure for fossil fuels and alternative fuels, etc. The executive order stipulates detailed rules on the display of the fuel price comparison, data provisions regarding the fuel prices as well as requirements for the calculations behind the fuel price comparison information.

In accordance with article 7.3 in AFID and recommendations from the PSA (FPC4-consumers), the rules are intended to promote simple and easily comparable consumer information about the price on different fuel types and thus give consumers the opportunity to assess the relative costs of selected fuels on the Danish market in DKK pr. 100 km.

The fuel price comparison user information can, with the exception of small retailers, be found on all fuel stations with three or more than three fuel points. The design of the fuel comparison signs differs in size and layout depending on the number of fuel points accessible at the concerned fuel station.

In the following, please find the average fuel prices for selected fuel types on the Danish market used for the purposes of the alternative fuels unit price comparison for the 1st quarter of 2022. These average fuel prices are currently used for the calculations behind the fuel price comparison information displayed at certain fuel stations in Denmark.

Fuel type	Average fuel price 1 st quarter 2022
Petrol	13,85 DKK/l ≈ 1,86 EUR/l
Diesel	12,74 DKK/l ≈ 1,71 EUR/l
Gas	20,51 DKK/kg ≈ 2,76 EUR/kg
Hydrogen	100,1 DKK/kg ≈ 13,46 EUR/kg
Electricity, home charging	3,22 DKK/kWh ≈ 0,43 EUR/kWh
Electricity, public charging	3,24 DKK/kWh ≈ 0,44 EUR/kWh
Electricity, public fast charging	4,84 DKK/kWh ≈ 0,65 EUR/kWh
